TELANGANA ACTS, ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS Etc.

The following Act of the Telangana Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 22nd September, 2019 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 22nd September, 2019 in the Telangana Gazette for general information:—

ACT No. 9 OF 2019.

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE PAYMENTS AND APPROPRIATION OF MONEYS FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF TELANGANA FOR THE SERVICES OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1ST APRIL, 2019.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Telangana in the Seventieth year of the Republic of India, as follows:-

Short Title

Appropriation of Rs.146547,12,51,000, from and out of the consolidated fund of the State of Telangana for the Financial year commencing on the 1st April, 2019.

- 1. This Act may be called the Telangana Appropriation (No.2) Act, 2019.
- 2. The State Government may appropriate from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Telangana, for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 2019, a sum not exceeding one lakh forty six thousand five hundred and forty seven crores, twelve lakhs and fifty one thousand rupees which shall be inclusive of the sum of Ninty one thousand thirty six crores twenty nine lakhs ninety two thousand five hundred rupees specified in Section 2 of the Telangana Appropriation (Vote-on-Account) Act, 2019 being moneys required to meet:-
- (a) the grants made by the Telangana Legislative Assembly for that year, as set-forth, in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Telangana, for the year, as set-forth in column (4) of the Schedule.
- 3. The sums authorised to be appropriated from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Telangana by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
